## A Word from the club manager



Dear club members and tennis fans,

The summer season is now in full swing. This year, we are not limited at the very start by the ongoing combined ATP Challenger and ITF women's tournament, which we were forced to cancel due to the National Sports Agency's late evaluation of our grant application. However, the latest information is that you will likely not miss out on the 26th edition of this traditional event, as after complex negotiations we managed to reschedule it for the second half of August (August 16–23, 2026), and we are now awaiting approval from the NSA. This week was, as it is every year, originally reserved for the ITF Junior International Tournament; in other words, we did not want to add another week of closed courts for our members during the summer season.

Following a successful Australian Open and a victory at the WTA 1000 tournament in Doha, Qatar, Karolína Muchová added another significant achievement by reaching the final of the WTA 500 tournament in Stuttgart, which brought her back into the world's top ten (currently ranked WTA 10). Nikola Bartůňková also took another step toward solidifying her place in the top 100 (currently WTA No. 65) by reaching the round of 16 in Rome and defeating Grand Slam champion Keys.

Work has been completed on the renovation of the restaurant terrace, landscaping around the access road and the pool area, including new paving and drainage channels. I believe these significant investments will contribute to the comfort and satisfaction of our members.

## Club day

The strongest group was won by the pair of Otto Šrejber and Lukáš Cyprih; in the Group B final, Petr Šavrdla and Michal Burian defeated the pair of Vlasta Bervid and Kateřina Kubíková Sr. in the final match of Group B. In Group C, Petr Pěchovič and his daughter Lily emerged victorious after a dramatic tiebreak final (5:4 over the pair of Tomáš Havel and Alexej Puškov), and Group D was dominated by Michael Šťastný and Richard Kočí.

The well-prepared refreshments, including a very good early-evening barbecue, set the stage for the now-traditional pub quiz, which was prepared and hosted in two versions by the well-known "hunter" Jakub Kvášovský. The very interesting individual competition was won by JUDr. Tomáš Havel, and the team competition was won by the younger generation under the team name Šavle.

We were very pleased by the large turnout of female club members, not only in the tournament but also by their formation of their own team, "Ženský element," for the quiz.

## Markéta Vondroušová's Tennis School

"The Štvanice Tennis School is enjoying one of the most successful seasons in its history, with around a hundred children currently training there. **Viktor Zhuk and Jakub Kožuský** advanced to the finals of the Czech Indoor Baby Tennis Championship (under-9 category) in Hradec Králové, and both also performed well at the prestigious Masters tournaments at I.ČLTK (photo) and Sparta (author's note: you can read more in the current issue of *I.ČLTK Revue* via the link [here](#)). Children's tournaments at Štvanice in the 2026 summer season will kick off their 35th series in early July; incidentally, past winners have included Tomáš Macháček, Nikola Bartůňková, Tereza Valentová, and Jonáš Forejtek. As part of the Prague Tennis Association's children's team competitions, a record nine Štvanice teams will be competing regularly in weekend matches this year. A total of six camps are scheduled for children during the summer holidays ([camp registration here](#)). "We believe that our youngest players will enjoy their summer at Štvanice and put on excellent performances," summarizes Jan Pecha, head coach of the tennis school.



## The Achievements of Karolína Muchová and Nikola Bartůňková

**Karolína Muchová** built on her success from February, when she won the WTA 1000 title in Doha, Qatar (photo). At the WTA 500 tournament in Stuttgart, Germany, Karolína reached her eighth WTA Tour final, but fell short against Elena Rybakina of Kazakhstan. She celebrated her first WTA tournament victory seven years ago in Seoul, and her second this year in Doha.



Following her success in Rome, where she surprisingly advanced to the round of 16 after defeating American Madison Keys, **Nikola Bartůňková** has reached a career-high ranking and is currently ranked 65th in the WTA world rankings.
