FLOOR RECONSTRUCTION

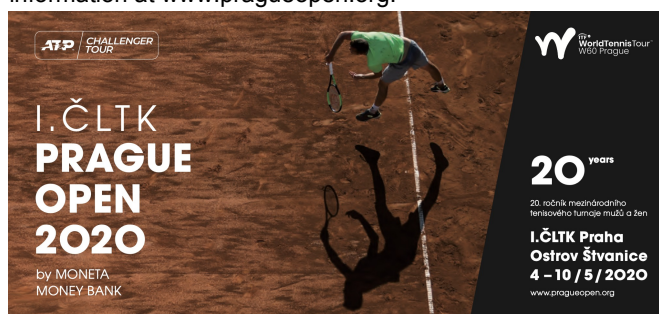

I.ČLTK PRAGUE OPEN 2020

The 20th edition of Prague Open at Štvanice will be played this year. This time with some big changes. What stays the same is that it will again be a combined tournament – men's ATP Challenger and women's ITF tournament. One big change is the date. Instead of July, this year the tournament will be played between May 4 – 10. The date is convenient because it comes just after the well-established Ostrava Challenger. Another positive is, that in the same week, only one other big tournament for both men and women will be played, the Madrid Masters. That promises better players for our tournament in both categories. The prize money for women's USD 60.000 ITF tournament stays the same, for men it will be doubled to EUR 92.000 + hospitality. That means we can expect some TOP 100 players in the main draw. Petr Foglar, a member of our club and private equity investor, shareholder of Proxy Finance a.s., is behind the increased prize money. We have also come to an agreement with him and we are extremely happy to announce that the name of this important event will be I.ČLTK Prague Open 2020 by MONETA Money Bank. Jan Šátral reached a quarterfinal in the same tournament. He lost to Julian Ocleppo from Italy 3/6 2/6.

Eliška Forejtková who partly plays at Štvanice won the indoor Czech Championships U12 at the beginning of February. Eliška was the number 2 seed and she won all her singles matches without losing a single set. In the final she defeated Alena Kovačková 7/6(2) 6/0. In doubles, with Monika Jiroušková, they reached semifinals.

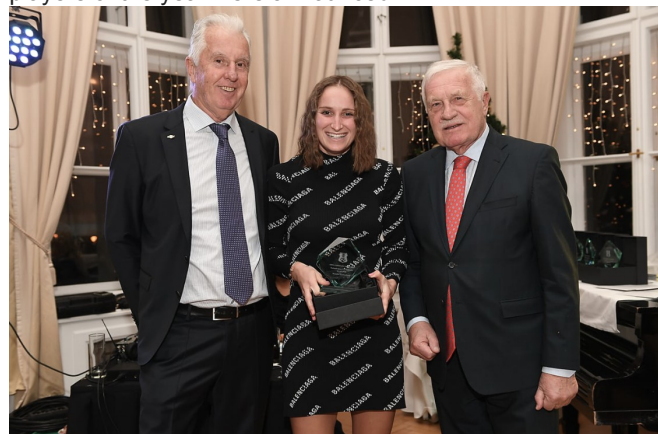
INTERNATIONAL JUNIOR TOURNAMENT
