KAROLÍNA MUCHOVÁ ATTACKS TOP 20

Karolína Muchová has had a successful season that finished in the semifinal of WTA Elite Trophy tournament. The I.ČLTK player lost to Aryna Sabalenka 5/7 6/7(4) and unfortunately was not able to reach the biggest final of her life. However, her run to the semifinals still meant that Karolína reached her new best highest position in the WTA ranking. She is now the world number 21 player.



Karolína's WTA ranking at the beginning of the year 2019 was 141. After reaching the quarterfinals in the Qatar Total Open in Doha, she fought for the title in Stromovka at the J&T Banka Prague Open. She reached the quarterfinals in Wimbledon and was able to repeat it in Bronx at the US Open. In September, she won her first WTA title is Soul, South Korea and one month later she reached the semifinals of the Kremlin Cup in Moscow.

MANAGER OF THE CLUB LOOKS BACK AT 2019



We are the end of a very successful season in competitive tennis for I.ČLTK Praha and I think it is worthwhile to remind ourselves of some of the biggest successes of our players. Markéta Vondroušová had an amazing first half of the year, reached the final of the French Open and was in sight of a TOP 10 position in the WTA ranking and even the November WTA Finals. Unfortunately, an injury and subsequent surgery prevented her from playing in the second half of 2019.

Karolína Muchová has vastly improved her

varied and attacking play and thanks to it reached the final at J&T Prague Open. After that she reached the quarterfinals in Wimbledon where she played Serena and was able to repeat it in Bronx at the US Open. In September, she won her first WTA title is Soul and reached the number 21 position in the WTA ranking.

Jonáš Forejtek became the ITF world number one player in September, before that he won the Pardubice Junior Championship rather easily and was sensational in his Davis Cup debut in Bosnia, winning 2 points.

Here I think we must acknowledge a great job both coaches did, Hernych and Mertl, who really did an amazing job and has proven that both will be great even in their new roles at the side of the court.

Nikola Bartůňková who is still only 14 years old also had a great season. Recently she became the number one player in the Tennis Europe ranking. She was also instrumental for the Czech team that won the U14 World title for our country.

PRAGUE OPEN 2020

Next year, in cooperation with Tennis Arena, I.ČLTK Praha will once again organize the international Prague Open tournament, its 20th year. The date of the event will be new 4 - 10 May. The ATP Challenger will have double the prize money (EUR 90 000), new general partner - Proxy Finance company and a new name - I.ČLTK Prague Open by Moneta Money Bank. The women's tournament will have the same prize money as this year (60 000 USD). More information at www.pragueopen.org.

JONÁŠ FOREJTEK AT THE ATP FINALS

After winning the junior title at the US Open, his first grand slam victory, Jonáš Forejtek reached the number one spot in the combined junior ranking. But that was not the end of his great season. At the beginning of November, Jonáš was in London at the ATP Finals where he was a sparing partner of the best players in the world. He was able to train and spar with Roger Federer, Alexander Zverev and the winner of the tournament Stefanos Tsitsipas.

SILVER FROM THE TEAM WORLD **CHAMPIONSHIPS**

At the end of September, the U16 Team World Championships was played at the brand new and beautiful tennis center in Orlando, USA. The Czech girls team gualified for the event thanks to winning silver medals at the European Championships.

In the first round the Czech girls defeated Thailand 2:0, in the semifinal the beat Russians 2:1 and in the final lost to Americans 1:2. Our club was represented at the event by Darja Vidmanova and coach Daniel Vaněk.

AMÉLIE ŠMEJKALOVÁ PLAYED FOR THE TITLE AT MASTERS

Amélie Šmejkalová reached the final of the U14 Tennis Europe Junior Masters tournament. Eight boys and girld played at the tournament from U14 and U16 categories. This tournament was played in 1996 for the first time and this was the ninth time in a row that it was played in Reggio Calabria, Italy.
