# Word from the club manager



Dear club members, dear tennis fans,

the second decade of June was marked by the extraordinary success of our players. It is of course led by Markéta Vondroušová who, after a long break caused by a shoulder injury, dominated the top-ranked "five hundred" in Berlin. On her way to the triumph she defeated three players of the world fifteen and among them the world number one Sabalenka, whose almost masculine tennis she eliminated with a great tactical game. So Keys (8th place), Shnaider (15th place), Jabeur (her opponent from the Wimbledon final), Sabalenka (1st place) and in the final Xin Yu Wang, who came through the main event without losing a set and with the scalp of world number two Gauff.

Jakub Nicod won his first tournament victory in the colours of I.ČLTK Praha at the ITF 25 tournament in Česká Lípa, It is very valuable, because he also struggled with health problems since his transfer from TK Sparta in January. The victory of our pair Paulson / Vocel at the ATP Challenger in Bratislava (USD 145 thousand) can also be considered a great success.

A stone fell from the hearts of our members and guests when negotiations about parking possibilities under the Negrelli viaduct were brought to an end. In the end, a contract was obtained for the lease of four arches, from which the posts will be removed and the aforementioned spaces will be marked with vertical signage with an additional plaque.

The reconstruction of court 9, which we are paying for from our own resources, has started these days and will have a new hard surface with a softening layer and several coatings. This investment amounts to around two million crowns

#### Markéta Vondroušová triumphs in Berlin

Markéta Vondroušová won her first title since Wimbledon 2023 at the grass court tournament in Berlin, Germany, defeating China's Xin Yu Wang in the final. This is her third WTA title overall.

"I enjoy every match. It's amazing to be here and play these matches again," beamed Markéta as she made her way towards the final after Saturday's triumph over world number one Aryna Sabalenka.

"We worked really hard to get back. And I feel like my team and I came here to try to win the first match especially. And now this happened! I'm incredibly grateful to be standing here," rejoiced Marketa after her final victory.

In the world rankings, where Vondrousova dropped to 164th place due to long absences, she moved up 91 places after the title in Berlin and is currently 73rd in the WTA world rankings. Unfortunately, at the third Grand Slam of the season at the All England Club in Wimbledon, London, Markéta lost to Emma Raducan 3/6 3/6 in the second round.

# **Achievements of I.ČLTK Praha players**

The first holiday weekend brought great success to three players of our club. **Darja Vidmanová** (photo) sovereignly dominated the ITF100 in the USA and moved up 73 places in the WTA ranking to 174th place, thus securing her participation in the US Open qualification.

Nikola Bartūňková was able to win the ITF category 30 tournament in Stuttgart, improving 80 places and continuing her comeback to the position she was deprived of by a penalty for alleged and unproven doping. By winning this tournament, she received a "special exemption" for the next ITF tournament in Frankfurt.

Veronika Sekerková entered the top 100 of the world ranking of players under 18 for the first time in her career after winning the ITF Junior 200 tournament in Pilsen and is currently ranked 95th.

The success of our players was completed by the victory at the junior ITF 200 category tournament in Mexico by 17year-old Jakub Šmejcký, who lost only one set during the whole tournament.



# Jakub Nicod winner of Macha Lake Open 2025



Jakub Nicod dominated the ITF category 25 tournament in Česká Lípa and won his seventh ITF title. He has now moved back into the top five in the ATP rankings.

Twenty-year-old player Jakub Nicod from Štvanice proved that if he is healthy, he is one of the biggest hopes of Czech tennis. He defeated Matthew Donald, Daniel Siniakov, Martin Krumich and Louis Wessels at the tournament in Česká Lípa. In the final, the fifth-seeded player defeated South African Alee Beckley 7:5. 6:1.

Nicod earned 25 points for the win and moved up to 462nd in the ATP rankings.

### A rare visit from AELTC

At the beginning of June, a friendly match with the guests from the prestigious Wimbledon AELTC took place at Štvanica. Eight mostly good players came and only doubles and mixes were played in pre-arranged age categories 40+, 50+ and 60+.

We lost 2:6, when two of our points were secured after a battle in the super-tiebreakers between Iva Simunkova and Karel Nováček and Petr Šavrda and Josef Kúrka. The result is not very important because the atmosphere of the matches and the social evening was very oleasant.

Even the English subtitled film about the 130-year history of the club was viewed with great interest by the guests, just as they enjoyed the Sunday boat trip on the Vltava River. Petr Šimūnek with his wife Iva and daughter Lucie, together with Helena Suková, took care of the precious guests.

The team of the Prague Tennis Association (photo) won the overall championship, the young hopefuls from the East Bohemia Regional Tennis Association came second and the third place went to the tennis players from the North Moravian Tennis Association.

The event organized by the I.ČLTK club and the Czech Tennis Federation was also attended by twotime Wimbledon doubles champion Barbora Strýcová, who will become the new captain of the Czech BJKC team from next season.
